As many of us remember it wasn't long ago Indian Lake Estates experienced a devastating fire. Please be aware of any burn bans that may be posted by Polk County and exercise extreme caution if you are burning yard debris or have a fire pit in use.

There are many activities on our May calendar. The clubhouse and 19th hole restaurant have games and musical entertainment throughout the month. The Bloodmobile is scheduled to be here May 2nd at 10am. Blood supplies are low, and your donations are desperately needed. I urge you to donate if you can. The Golf Course is looking great and tee times are more available as our winter guests and residents continue to head back North. A drainage project is underway but should be completed in time as not to interfere with play.

The Board of Directors continues to work on improving and beautifying Indian Lake Estates. We have received bids for road paving and additional bracing on the pier. 2024 is expected to have a very active Hurricane Season and strengthening the pier is vital to maintaining its integrity. Our audit was conducted, and the final numbers should be available mid-month to help us understand what monies are available to spend. While the budgets were approved, we must remain diligent to spend wisely and not compromise our financial stability.

In closing I have always tried to be positive when writing these messages unfortunately this month there has been a rash of incidents of wanton and deliberate destruction of Indian Lake Estates and residents' property. This behavior cannot and will not be tolerated. The business manager is working in conjunction with Polk County Sheriffs to come up with a plan and strategy to address this situation. Anyone destroying property can expect to be prosecuted to the full extent of the law. If you have any information, please notify the business office, you will remain anonymous.

The last two pieces of Equipment the Community approved arrived well under the allotment the Community approved. The Purchase was a Team effort of B.O.D and Staff to achieve this with best interest of ILE Community in mind. We have started Spring Selective Herbicide Program to kill weeds (grow faster than Turf Grass) which saves on fuel costs and Labor. The Browning effects on Turf Grass from Spaying Selective Herbicide is very temporary and causes no permanent damage to Turf Grass. The Browning of Turf is not caused by lack of Irrigation. The Community and Past and Present Board members have wisely supported the completion of Irrigation. The irrigation was done in Phases to have minimal effect on Community. The benefits of Irrigation moving forward will reap many rewards for Community. The Pro Shop Manager Robin Samson announced starting May 1st to October 3rd rates for 18 -holes- \$25 and 9 -holes- \$17 tax included. I would encourage evening Play the cool evening and atmosphere of Golf Course is great. 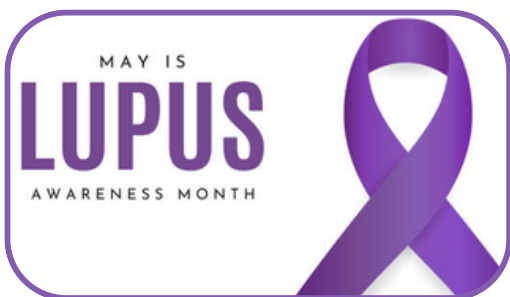
